Distinguished Service Award

Awarded to a NZAHS Member for "special services" to the NZAHS and Arabian breed in NZ.

Written nomination to be submitted to qualify the nomination.

Life Membership

Life Membership may be granted to recognise a NZAHS Member whose lifetime of dedication & achievement has contributed significantly to the NZAHS and the Arabian Breed in New Zealand.

Written nomination to be submitted to qualify the nomination.

NZAHHS Brian Ross Young Achiever Award

The purpose of the NZAHS Young Achiever Award is to recognise high levels of achievement by young members of our Arabian community. In honouring our Young Achievers, we are setting the cornerstones in place for their ongoing involvement with the Arabian Horse.

Nominees must ∞ 1) Not have attained their 18th birthday by the published closing date; 2) Have achieved recognisable success with their NZAHS registered Purebred or Derivative Arabian horse within New Zealand and/or overseas; 3) The horse must compete under its NZAHS registered name; 4) Fully complete the application form (available to download off NZAHS website) accompanied by a written nomination detailing the nominee's involvement & achievements with the Arabian breed.

WAHO Award

A beautiful bronze trophy, specially commissioned by the World Arabian Horse Organization from German artist/sculptor, Mrs Brigitte Eberl.

Nominee criteria ∞ 1) The horse must be Purebred, registered with the NZAHS & compete under its registered name; 2) The horse must be bred & domiciled in New Zealand; 3) The horse must be alive at the time of nomination; 4) Nominees should be Arabian horses that have, in some way, been an excellent "ambassador" for the breed, or in the case of older horses, achieved the same through immediate progeny; 5) Nominations invited over all disciplines & not limited to halter horses only; 6) The owner of the horse must be a current NZAHS Member.

Written nomination to be submitted to qualify the nomination.

Derivative of the Year Award

A perpetual trophy donated by Taralea Arabians & Woodlau Farm.

Nominee criteria ∞ 1) The horse must be a Derivative & registered with the NZAHS; 2) The horse must be bred & domiciled in New Zealand; 3) The horse must be alive at the time of nomination; 4) Nominees should be Derivative Arabian horses that have, in some way, been an excellent "ambassador" for the breed, or in the case of older horses, achieved the same through immediate progeny; 5) Nominations invited over all disciplines & not limited to halter horses only; 6) The owner of the horse must be a current NZAHS Member.

Written nomination to be submitted to qualify the nomination.
