These young people can be participating in endurance events, show jumping, cross country or pony club. They may assist at a horse stud, but their horse of choice is a Purebred or Derivative Arabian horse. Young people are the future forward for the NZAHS and in honouring our Young Achievers, we are setting the cornerstones in place for their ongoing involvement with the Arabian Horse.

The applicant must:

- Not have attained their 18th birthday by the published closing date.
- Have achieved recognisable success with their NZAHS registered Purebred or Derivative Arabian horse within New Zealand. It must also compete under its NZAHS registered name.
- Applicants may also have been selected to represent New Zealand offshore.
- Fully complete the entry form (available to download off the NZAHS website) and attach a written summary of the applicant's involvement and achievements with the Arabian breed.
- Applicants or their families do not need to be NZAHS members.
