RULES & CONDITIONS

 All entries foaled before 1st August of year preceding show are to be registered in the approved NZ Arabian Horse Society stud books before closing date of show. NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED WITHOUT REGISTRATION NUMBER.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that their NZAHS registration number is provided at time of entry.

"Eligibility of Purebred Foals for showing at a show run under NZAHS Rules of Showing"

Horses to be shown must be registered with the New Zealand Arabian Horse Society (Inc) or in the case of foals, be eligible for registration. Eligibility is defined as being: that the sire and dam of the foal are DNA'd at the time of close of entries for the show and that the breeder/exhibitor is, through full and current financial membership of the NZAHS, eligible to register the foal that is being entered for the show.

"Imported Horses" Imported horses may not be shown until New Zealand registration (including DNA information) is completed and a certificate issued.

2. All entries must be made on the printed entry form enclosed.

4. ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES - internet banking must be received at time of entry. There will be no refund of entry fees in any circumstances, except 75% on presentation of a doctors/veterinary certificate of unfitness on the day of the show. Doctors/Vet Certificate must be produced on or before the day of the show.

- 5. In all classes the name of the horse, sex, date of birth, sire, dam & stud book number must appear on the Entry Form.
- 6. The Committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the programme or to postpone or cancel the show or any class as it sees fit.

7. JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT

- Led 8.30am SHARP
- Ridden Will follow on at the completion of the Led Sections
- 8. Exhibitors are to proceed from marshalling area to class holding area, while previous class is being judged. If at completion of previous class you are not in the holding ring you will not be admitted. Exhibitors showing horses in consecutive classes must have sufficient handlers to have their horses ready in holding area.
- 9. Competitors in the Derivative Led and Ridden Sections must produce a current height certificate on request.
- 10. **BACK NUMBERS**: If back numbers are not returned, a charge of \$5.00 per back number will be made.
- 11. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident loss or damage that may be caused to, or suffered by any exhibit, person or property, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage.
- 12. **PROTESTS**: All protests must be in writing and be lodged with the Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of \$20.00 which shall be refunded only if the Protest is upheld. The decision of the Protests Committee shall be final.
- 13. In all Ridden Classes horses must be 3 years & over.
- 14. Judging will be in accordance with NZAHS "Rules for Judging & Showing Arabian Horses."
- 15. Entries in Gelding classes must have been gelded, Copy of Registration Certificate must be produced on demand.
- 16. Excessive use of the whip will result in the handler being required to leave the ring on the instructions of the Ring Steward or Judge. Horses with whip marks will not be judged.
- 17. All Horses must be registered with the NZAHS and exhibited in the name of the bona fide owner or leasee(s) (all leases must registered with the NZAHS).
- 18. Please note the NZAHS Rule that states that no Colt or Stallion can be handled by any person under the age of 18 years.

19. Safety Helmets – ALL riders must wear an approved safety helmet that complies with the safety standard accepted by Equestrian Sport NZ (ESNZ), NZ Pony Clubs Association (NZPCA) and the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ (RAS). Such helmets shall be tagged with a compliant visible YELLOW tag. Any rider whose helmet is not appropriately tagged will not be permitted to enter the ring. (this includes Costume classes)
