(Inc) Rules for Showing & Judging Horses**

RULES OF SHOW

(Under NZ Occupational Health & Safety Act it is the responsibility of EVERYONE on the grounds to ensure these rules are adhered to. The Committee reserves the right to deal with anyone breaching these rules which may include instant removal from the grounds).

All entries to be registered with the NZ Arab Horse Breeders Society. NO ENTRY will be accepted without copy of registration certificate, except for foals.

In all classes the registered name of the Horse/Pony, date of birth Sire, Dam, together with the Registration Number MUST appear on the Entry Form. Age of the Horse/Pony computed as at 1st August 2019.

Entry Fee must accompany entries by CHEQUE. Entries close 10 January 2020. Post dated cheques dated no later than 10th January 2020 will be accepted to enable prompt completion of Catalogue. Late entries on Show Day. 50% penalty. Applications for refunds will be at the discretion of the show committee

The Committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the programme, combining classes with insufficient entries, postpone or cancel the show or classes as it sees fit.

The Committee will not be held responsible for any accident, or loss, or damage, that may be caused to, or suffered by any exhibit exhibitor or spectator. It shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any such accident, loss or damage. All persons and their property enter the grounds at their own risk.

Purebreds – in halter classes, only geldings may be shown plaited. Plaiting is optional in the ridden classes. Derivatives - Plaiting is optional for all inhand and ridden classes.

No tie downs to be used in any flat class.

Broodmare – is a mare with a foal at foot or due to foal 1st August and 31 July of the current show season. A mare without a foal at foot (ie has weaned a foal or is yet to foal) must have a veterinary certificate. An infoal mare is a mare which is due to foal after August 1st in the year following the current show season. She must have a veterinary certificate.

Ridden horses/ponies must carry a current height certificate

PROTESTS. All protests must be in writing and lodged with the Secretary within ten minutes and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 (Fifty Dollars) which shall be refunded only if the protest is upheld. The decision of the Protest Committee shall be final.

Once judging has commenced LATE ARRIVALS will not be admitted into the ring. Only exception permissible is if you have two horses showing in consecutive classes. Please notify Gate Steward prior to your first class of your possible delay.

STABLES. Stables must be left clean. Stallions, Colts and Mares with foals have first priority. The Stables Steward can request that any unruly or unhealthy horse be removed from stables to another area.

NO Horse/Pony under the age of 3 years is eligible for ridden events.

The winners of perpetual trophies will be liable for the safe keeping of those trophies. Any loss or damage must be reported to the Club Secretary and the exhibitor will be responsible for the full replacement.

NO DOGS ALLOWED. This is a venue rule and will be strictly enforced – any person with a dog will be disqualified and forfeit all paid entry fees

No temporary tape fences to be erected on show grounds.

All competitors must conduct themselves in a good sporting manner. Failure to do so can result in being eliminated from participating in any more events on the day in question, if there is a complaint made against their behaviour, and the protest

The Committee at its absolute discretion may refuse an entry or cancel any entry already accepted or decline to admit to the show grounds or remove any animal, exhibitor or person from the said grounds.

Excessive use of the whip or chain on a horse anywhere in the showgrounds at anytime during the duration of the show is strictly forbidden, any person involved in this will be requested to leave the show grounds and the horse involved will be eliminated from all entered classes. Any horse with welt marks will also be eliminated immediately. There will be NO refund of entry fees. The show committees decision is final.

Novice events – all novice events snaffle bridle only, no exceptions. Novice horses/ponies may compete in the open classes

Youth ridden events – snaffle bridle only and no spurs allowed

The Judges' decision is final

Stabling – stallions and colts must be stabled for the duration of their stay. All horses must be stabled or yarded for the duration of their stay

All chains on inhand halters must be caught ie must not lie against the horses jaw or the must have a leather guard

Random drug testing may be conducted

Any horse that gets loose and leaves the arena, automatic disqualification from that class, no exceptions.

All handlers/riders of stallions must be 18yrs and over.

One horse one handler per class or one horse per rider per class – it is on the onus of the handler/rider with more than one horse eligible for a class/championship to nominate the horse they will lead/ride and organise further rider(s), handler(s) for any other eligible horse(s)

HELMET TAGGING – all riders must wear approved tagged helmets in all ridden classes. Accepted safety standards can be found on the ESNZ website

MUSIC IS COMPULSORY

Please put your music on a disk and give to the show secretary before 12pm Saturday 18th January

Each horse and rider combination completes a free workout in a set time of 2 minutes.

Procedure: time will commence as soon as you enter the arena. A warning bell will sound 30 seconds prior to the end of the time limit to allow for completion of Movement. If time is exceeded the second bell will ring and you will be required to leave the arena immediately, judging will have ceased at this point.

The workout must include the following compulsory moves:

Canter serpentine of 3 loops, with trot or walk changes

Walk on a loose rein

Rein back

Extended trot

Halt to canter

You will be judged by 2 judges.

Competitors will be scored on the different compulsory moves as well as presentation, difficulty and originality, paces and manners, quality and conformation. Each section will be marked out of 10 points for a mark of 100

If there is a tied score, the exhibit with the highest marks scored on the compulsory moves will be awarded the winner. Horses are to be presented and ridden as open hack riding attire and tack. No dressage whips are permitted.
